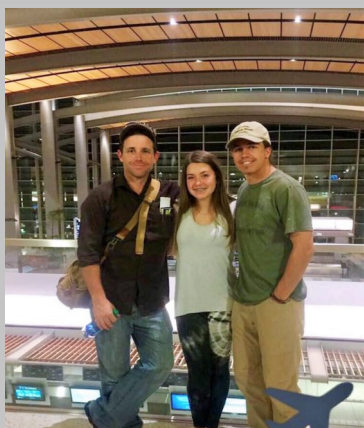

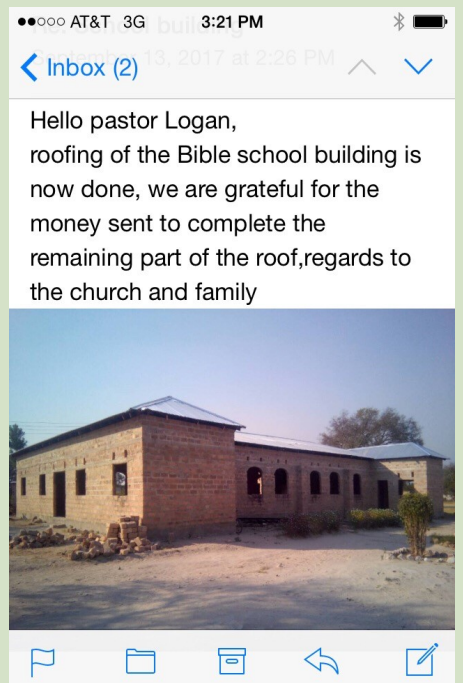
Mikel and John, met with the youth of the village daily. They attended the daily teaching, assisted, and as you will hear them both say, they were at times students as well. When
